Applicant, Paul Newman and his wife Lorraine were present. They explained they would like to install an above ground pool within their existing lawn. They are using Pool Pro's for the installation. The land will need to be leveled and sand will be brought in and compacted to be used for the base. In addition, upon completion of the installation, Newman would like to install an approximately 3 foot walkway around the pool. Once the pool is filled with water, it will not be drained. If any issues arise, and water needs to be removed, they will use a truck to extract the water and not drain directly onto property.

Meister explained to applicant that this type of work is not typically allowed, however since the pool will be installed on existing lawn area and there are no other issues, he believes this project can move forward.

Arguimbau asked if there was a plan noting the location of where the pool will be installed on property. (On file in office).

BOH has reviewed the plans to ensure location is not near the leaching field. They suggested to follow up with Conservation, which applicants are now doing.
