 - a) Overview of 604b and MVP Action programs, elements of a Watershed-Based Plan (WBP), embedding it in climate resiliency and engaging constituencies and EJ communities. A successful WBP can lead to access to 319 implementation funds for best management practices (BMPs), and future MVP Action funds for design and implementation of projects to reduce excess nutrients in relation to the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL). A TMDL is the highest amount of a pollutant a waterbody can take and still meet standards for healthy systems.
 - b) Review roles, phases (FY24 and FY25), engagement strategies, and deliverables for the two grants, outline specifics for administration, reporting, deliverables, reimbursement, monitoring and completion of the grants. Tips from other grants/grantees.
