#### Administration

- The meeting of the Sharon Standing Building Committee was called to order by Chair Gladstone at 6:30 PM at the Public Safety Building.
- o Future scheduled meetings: 9/5, 9/19, 10/3, 10/17, 10/31

## **Town Hall Renovation Project**

- Mr. Paton commented that nothing has changed over the past two weeks.
   They performed a hazardous material check at the fire station and Town Hall roofs and masonry and found no hazardous materials. The test results were clean.
- The revised budget for hazardous materials is\$332,000.
- Richard Marks and Kevin Paton are working on an updated project budget.
- The Town Hall project will be a warrant article.
- A brief conversation ensued regarding the placement of an electronic message board at the site. Mr. Paton will speak with Mr. Turkington regarding placement, taking the current monuments into account.
- Mr. Paton showed two samples of planks for the building and will bring these two color choices in renderings to the next meeting.
- Mr. Gladstone said the Mr. Turkington and Ms. Chused requested that King Company be allowed to do a study at a cost of \$5,600 to determine how to best archive and store. A brief discussion ensued. The Committee determined this was a good idea to help establish a program for storage. Mr.

Paton will tell Mr. Turkington that the consensus of the Committee is to incorporate this cost.

## Public Safety Building Kaestle Boos Architects Report

- 0 pending submittal, 0 open RFI's, 6 open change order requests that Consigli is pricing or KBA is reviewing. 465 RFI's submitted to date.
- Pricing for the microphones and proposed flat roof system at the watch room will be reviewed at the next meeting. KBA will at the next meeting have a photo shopped rendering of the watch room canopy for review.
- Mr. Costa is working to get affidavits ready for the 8/31 occupancy.

### Consigli

- The Construction Managers Report was presented and reviewed. The current GMP is \$19,589, 971.
- Slater/Rice moved to approve change order #16 for \$78,507.00. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of approval.

#### **Daedalus**

- Mr. Sullivan stated Consigli is doing the close out schedule.
- The 11 month walk through warranty for the police station is next week. A punch list will be created.

## **Heights Elementary School Roof Project**

- Mr. Walsh commented that the roof has been 100% replaced. There are still
  perimeter areas that are not yet complete. It is 85% in terms of request for
  payment. They are moving into the punch list phase and target completion
  this week. He commented that the SGH assessment was Greenwood did
  the work well.
- Tuck/Rice moved and seconded approval for the requisition for the roof project in the amount of \$525,187.03.
- Mr. Walsh said they are tracking change orders at \$55,053 currently but expect them to be less.

#### **Minutes**

Mr. Rice moved to accept the minutes of 8/22/17. Ms. Tuck seconded the motion and the Committee voted in favor of approval.

#### **Invoices**

Mr. Smith moved to approve all invoices. Ms. Rice seconded the motion and the Committee voted unanimously in favor of approval.
