Annual Septic Variance Fees_(BOH Revolving Fund)

Residential Systems: January 1st

- For systems requiring a variance (not including I/A systems); \$50
- For systems including I/A systems. \$100

Commercial Systems: January 1st

- For systems requiring a variance (not including I/A systems); \$100
- For systems including I/A systems \$200

Initial plan review/initial site inspections_(for sanitation purposes): (Voted 6/25/07)

- Supermarkets: \$300
- Restaurants and dining areas for highly-susceptible populations (HSP's) \$200
(No charge for non-profit food facilities)
- For semi-public, public, and commercial swimming pools and spas \$150
- For all other food service facilities, nail salons, massage and body art establishments, motels, hotels, and camps, as well as any and all unspecified items requiring plan review and/or site inspections for sanitation purposes \$100

For all of the above categories

- Revisions to plans: \$25

Well construction permit (Prior to well construction) \$50

Re-inspection Fee (Voted 6/25/07)

- Non-compliance/code violations
\$50 per re-inspection required by Health Department
