Meeting called to order at 7:14 PM

Lois is concerned about inviting town departments because they may want to set up exhibits at a table and that would limit the space for vendors in from the community.

Lois read her letter to the group and noticed that she listed the wrong date and time so she made note of it to correct it later.

Marketing and PR will consist of local newspapers, flyers around town, The VIEW (Sharon Adult Center Newsletter) and other projects which we will discuss at future meetings.

Linda Salon who is on the 250<sup>th</sup> committee used to be on the commission and could be a great resource.

We have been approved to have a presence at square jam in August. We are not allowed to sell anything or exchange money, but we could hand out order forms and display the T shirts in case anyone wanted to purchase one later.

There was some discussion as to whether we should order the t shirts in a baby onesie size.

Paul and Susan met with Rinah of the Binah school who is excited about the T shirts.

It has been decided that we will wear the T shirts while marching in the 250<sup>th</sup> parade in the Fall. There was some discussion about buying a banner that we could use in the parade and also at DAD.
