**Meeting Minutes**

Committee voted (3-0-0) in favor of approval of meeting minutes for 11/27/18.

**Municipal Aggregation Broker**

Since our last meeting Town Selectmen voted to sign the contract with MassPowerChoice for Energy Broker for town aggregation. George Aronson said that the MassPowerChoice had signed the contract but we were still waiting on the town signature. It was expected to happen shortly.

MassPowerChoice's Paul Gromer and Kim Pare decided to move forward with the aggregation process anyways and came to the meeting. The committee discussed timelines, overall approach, sample supply contract, and a community input session.

- Committee decided to tentatively to hold community input meeting on 1/30/19 at town library.
- George Aronson and Silas Fyler with town council would review sample supply contract
- Lajos Kamocsay would book library and Valerie White would handle Sharon TV
- Silas Fyler would gather documents needed for draft aggregation plan ( town envelope, town seal, logos, certified town meeting vote) and handle media posting around town
- Committee voted 5-0-0 to name the program Sharon Power Choice

**RFP for Solar on town owned land**

Committee restarted discussed status of RFP for solar contract. George Aronson will get together with Fred Turkington to discuss RFP.

Sachin Patel will work with Ken Wertz to develop a list of sites on School properties that might be included in a Town RFP and how that process with work with the school committees.
