- 1. Approval of previous meeting minutes for November, December, and January meetings.
- 2. The board unanimously approved contract from PSC. Contingent on Town confirming final contract amount with PSC.
- 3. According to the town, the original contact with STV can and will be terminated, and leftover funds will be used for the new contact with PSC.
- 4. It was brought to the board attention that the MBTA contract with the Town regarding the Sharon station parking lot, was up for renewal and being negotiated. As a board we asked Peter O'Cain and any members that have the availability, to share our concerns and questions at the upcoming meeting between the town and MBTA.
 - a. Would the MBTA consider making neighboring rail station parking lots available for Sharon residents with parking permits as overflow if parking is unavailable in Sharon.
 - b. Would the MBTA consider managing the train station lot, and if so at what cost or considerations must be made.
 - c. Could the parking spots on the providence side that are resident spaces be made quarterly pass holder spaces rather than the daily spaces they are right now.
- 5. Discussed a ride share program. We are looking into receiving more information about a town rail station that partnered with Lyft in Summit NJ.
