1. Summary Description

The Sharon Recreation Summer Camp Supervisor undertakes the responsibility of planning and delivery of activities at Camp Massapoag that are safe, fun, and appropriate to the all ages and abilities. Provide management to the physical operation of the Camp's facilities and equipment.

Plan, direct, and supervise a safe and fun Camp program. Write (with the help of counselors) camp weekly goals that meet Camp Goals set by Recreation Director. Evaluate counselors abilities for each specific sport camp. Deliver creative camp program activities.

Train and supervise camp staff. Assist in the planning and implementation of staff training. Train camp staff in their counselor responsibilities. Supervise camp staff to provide a safe and high-quality program. Supervise the camp staff evaluation process. Implement the scheduling of camp staff. Directly supervise all camp staff.

Manage the physical facilities and equipment in the camp program area. Set up camp area prior to each day's beginning as well during staff training. Teach and monitor proper use of equipment.

Conduct initial and end-of-season inventory, and store equipment for safety. Check equipment, and make (or file for) repairs. Conduct a daily check of equipment for safety, cleanliness, and good repair. Submit orders for equipment and supplies when needed, ensuring timely arrival of materials. Survey waterfront area daily, and keep the area free of hazards and debris.
