Meeting Initiation

ANR Cumberland Farms

Doug Troyer, Attorney for Cumberland Farms came before the Board to discuss Cumberland Farms combining two parcels of land at 431 and 435 South Main Street. They want to build a 4,250 square foot convenience store; change the location of the gas pumps and increase the number of pumps from 4 to 8. He stated they will need to upgrade the storage tanks underground, add diesel fuel to one tank, reduce the curb cuts and define other curb cuts better. They have approached the abutters and one abutter requested trees be planted as a buffer to her property.

The hours of operation for the site will be 5am - 10pm. Cumberland Farms will need to go back to the ZBA after 1 year to ensure the hours are working out. This building design is a new formula for Cumberland Farms. It will dramatically improve the look of the existing site. The abutting property which they purchased is the former jewelry store. Construction will begin in the spring. Heights Elementary School administration has been informed of the project and delivery times to Cumberland Farms will be adjusted so as not to affect school pick up or drop off times.

Mr. Blaszkowsky moved to approve the ANR for 431 and 433 South Main Street for Cumberland Farms as presented. Mr. Pannone seconded the motion and the Board voted 4-0-0 in favor of approval.
