Update on Cedar Swamp

Meister informed the Commission that the first layer of riprap was installed about a year ago. The monitoring wells up the ditch are being monitored monthly. About one week ago, Peter Fletcher and Meister put on another layer of riprap on top of the dam.

Meister is working with hydrologist who is advising on the project.

The level of ground water in town is low. The pond near the dog park is very low. Boards had to be used again at the flume house due to the low water level.

11 Deerfield Road – The survey has been completed. A consultant was hired and they are moving ahead with correcting the Notice of Intent. The consultant is keeping Meister in the loop with what is going on at the property.

Homes along Norwood Street – a Commission member inquired if any of the new homes were adjacent to the wetlands. According to Meister, there are none.

Pinewoods – at the far end of Norwood Street there is an intermittent stream. Also, on Everett Street, towards the museum, there are wetlands.

Next Conservation Commission meeting is scheduled for December 19th.

Meister reminded the Commission that he sent out information on the Open Meeting Law and State Ethics. Commission members must sign off that they have read the Ethics document and that the sign off sheet should be returned to the Town Clerks office.
