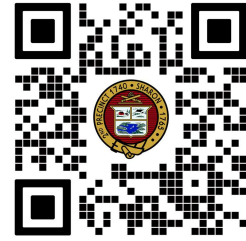

Dear Current and Future Registered Voters,

The State Election has passed. Please visit <https://www.townofsharon.net/town-clerk/pages/elections-state-election-110822> for useful links and more detailed information for all items below and more. For your convenience, you can get to this information by scanning the included QR code and clicking on "For 2022 State Election Information".

Our preliminary voter totals show a whopping 8,120 voters which is 61% of registered voters. This is a great turnout, one that is evidenced by the very long line in the last few hours of the election. I do apologize to all those who waited in the cold, but I also want to say how proud I am of the turnout for this election. During the hour of 6:00pm-7:00pm we had an amazing 361 members of our community vote.

On November 15th (previously planned for the 14th) at 11:30am Post Election Tabulation will occur at the Town Clerk's Office. At this time ballots that were mailed to Town Hall postmarked by November 8th and mailed from within the United States and received by 5:00pm on November 12th will be hand-tallied and added to the totals. Unfortunately, the memory card containing results from the Advance Deposited ballots from Precinct 2 failed to read and produce results on November 8th. As a result, we will also be re-tabulating the Advance Deposited Ballots from Precinct 2. This event is open to the Public.

Finally, at the November 21st Board of Registrars Meeting to be held in the Town Clerk's Office at 7:30pm, ballots postmarked by November 8th, mailed from outside the United States and received by 5:00pm on November 18th will be hand-tallied. These final votes will be added to our totals, for certification on November 22nd. This event is open to the public.

Thank you to everyone who participated in this election, be you poll worker, voter or both. The Town of Sharon should be proud of your participation in the electoral process.
