Dear Current and Future Registered Voters,

The September 6th Primary Day is almost here. If you still have your ballot, please return it as soon as possible. Please consider doing so in the drop box at Town Hall or directly to the Town Clerk's Office, to ensure we receive it in time. I strongly suggest avoiding putting it through the mail. Vote By Mail ballots MUST be received at Town Hall by 8:00pm on Primary Day! DO NOT bring Vote By Mail ballots to the High School.

For your convenience, you can get to this information by scanning the included QR code and clicking on "For 2022 State Primary Information".

The highlighted area has been approved by the School Department for parking for the Primary. School starts at 8:00am and ends at 2:40pm. Due to traffic issues around the start and end of the school day, I strongly recommend avoiding those times. I have asked my staff not to park in the horseshoe-shaped section of the lot, in order to leave those spaces for the voters. I ask that the political campaign staff also avoid parking there.

The entrance/exit for the Primary is past the Main Entrance of the school. <u>DO NOT</u> use the Main Entrance. There will be signs directing you from the parking lot to the proper entrance.
