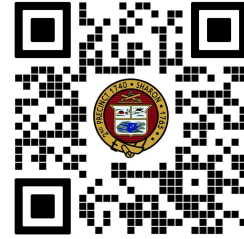

Dear Current and Future Registered Voters,

This year on March 5th, when you're celebrating the 254th Anniversary of the Boston Massacre, don't forget to take some time to vote in the Presidential Primary. The following is some helpful information on the Primary. Any online resources mentioned below can be found by scanning the QR code or by visiting: www.townofsharon.net/town-clerk.

Register to Vote:

The last day to register to vote for the March 5th Primary is Saturday, February 24th. The Town Clerk's office will be open from 9:00am – 5:00pm on that day. You may also register until 11:59:59pm online.

Vote By-Mail:

- Vote By-Mail Applications are only good for one calendar year. If you have turned in an application in previous years, it will not count for this year. You must fill out a new one for 2024.
- Applications to vote by mail have been sent from the Secretary of the Commonwealth. If you do not have one yet, you should shortly. If you would like to vote by mail and do not receive an application, you can get one online.
- There are four options on the application: All 2024 Elections; March 5th Presidential Primary; September 3rd State Primary; or November 5th State (Presidential) Election.
- By checking off individual elections you will only get ballots for those elections. If you check off all elections you will receive a ballot for all elections, including the May 21st Annual Town Election.
- If you are registered as Unenrolled, or any designation that is not Democrat, Republican, or Libertarian, and you want to vote in a Primary, you must indicate if you want a Democratic, a Republican, or a Libertarian Ballot. If you do not indicate the style of ballot, or if you check off more than one, you will not receive any.
- If you are registered as a Democrat, a Republican, or a Libertarian, you will receive your Party's Ballot.
- Applications may be returned by mail, in person at the Town Clerk's Office, or in the drop box located in the foyer of Town Hall. Applications may also be submitted by fax to (781) 784-1518 or by email to vote@townofsharon.org. The signature must be signed in substantially the same manner as a handwritten signature (signed by mouse, stylus, or finger). Applications with typed signatures or no signatures will not be accepted. All applications must be received by the Town Clerk's Office no later than 5:00pm on February 27th. I strongly encourage you not to wait that long.

Early In-Person Voting:

Will be held in the Town Clerk's Office at the following times:

Saturday & Sunday:	02/24 & 25	– 9:00am – 12:00pm
Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday:	02/26, 27 & 28	– 8:00am – 5:00pm
Thursday:	02/29	– 8:00am – 6:00pm
Friday:	03/01	– 8:00am – 12:30pm

Vote In-Person on Primary Day:

The March 5th Primary will be held at Sharon High School. The polls will open at 7:00am and close at 8:00pm.
