Halloween 2020

- Small family groups should remain 6 feet from others, wear cloth face coverings, use hand sanitizer and/or wash hands before and after trick or treating, and if you are feeling any symptoms of COVID-19 or experiencing a fever, please stay home.
- The suggested time for trick-or-treating on 10/31 is 5:00pm - 8:00pm.
- If your household does not wish to participate in trick-or-treating, please turn OFF your outdoor light and/or post a sign that says, "Please, no trick or treating."
- Please respect those houses that choose not to participate!
- We encourage residents to engage in "one-way trick or treating" - you leave candy in a bowl or spread on a table outside your door/in driveway, and participate from behind a storm door or window to wave at children in costume.
- Be mindful of children with food allergies, including nuts - place a teal pumpkin or some other teal-colored identifier to let kids know that the treats are allergy friendly or that you have non-food treats available.

Halloween & trick or treating is not a town sponsored or town sanctioned event. These instructions are guidelines that we ask residents to follow in order to promote a fun & safe holiday celebration for everyone. Thank you for your cooperation & we wish you a safe & happy Halloween!
